THE GRANDPA SAVINO FLUKE TOURNAMENT RULES AND REGULATIONS
THE FOLLOWING RULES AND REGULATIONS MUST BE STRICTLY ADHERED TO IN ORDER TO BE ELIGIBLE FOR THE PRIZES DESCRIBED BELOW

1. The Grandpa Savino Fluke Tournament will be conducted by the Staten Island Tuna Club beginning at 4:00 a.m. Saturday July 22, 2017, and ending Saturday, July 22, 2017 at 5:30 p.m.
2. The Captains meeting will be held Friday, July 21 at 5:00-7:00 pm. A representative of each entered boat must attend the Captain's Meeting, and sign this Rules and Regulations page, and pay the fee prior to entering the tournament.
3. Entry fee will be \$100 per boat. There will be winners based on 1st, 2nd, 3rd place combined weight of 3 Fluke. In the event no fish are caught or tournament is cancelled due to weather on both days, the prize money will be raffled off in equal amounts. In the event only one boat has eligible fluke weighed in, it will be awarded the total pot
4. Prize money. In the event only two boats have eligible fluke weighed in, the third place prize will be split equally between first and second place. Only legal fish are eligible to be weighed in. Currently in NYS a Fluke must be 18" or greater to retain.
5. Only one grand prize will be awarded in the Doormat Division, a separate entry fee of \$100 per boat is required to enter this division. The Grand Prize will be awarded to the single heaviest fluke over 13.00 lbs. A mandatory polygraph test will be performed prior to the award for any fluke over 13.00lbs. If there is an exact tie in the doormat division, the prize will be split.
6. Only one prize per boat. The Doormat Division winner may be on one of the prize winning boats.
7. Tournament boundaries are Debb's Inlet to Seaside Heights to George Washington Bridge.
8. **Fish can only be weighed in between 3:30pm thru 5:30pm on July 22, 2017 at Captains Marina, in Staten Island.** The participant with an eligible fish to weigh-in, must be present and signed in with the weighmaster at the scale with the fish by no later than 5:30pm, on Saturday July 22, 2017.
9. Fishing is by rod and reel only. Tackle is unlimited as to test line, leader length, and double line. Only six (6) lines per boat may be used at one time.
10. Each angler must supply his own bait, be aware that IGFA rules do not allow bellies of fish that are shorter than permissible to keep.
11. This tournament will abide by all state and federal rules, regulations and laws in the manner prescribed by the International Game Fishing Association (IGFA), international angling rules and those of the State of New York Department of Environmental Conservation.
12. Tournament weigh in station will be at Captains Marina – 202 Mansion Ave. Staten Island, NY, 10308
13. The Staten Island Tuna Club reserves the right to retain any winning fish.
14. 1st 2nd and 3rd place prizes will be distributed on Tuesday following contest and confirmation of weights at Captains Marina. A polygraph test may be required.
15. Boats fishing during small craft warnings do so at their own risk. You further acknowledge that the decision to proceed or withdraw, with or without refund, is the sole responsibility of the Captain. You, as Captain, will hold the Club harmless should any weather related casualty occur and will indemnify it should any of your crew elect to sue the Club for weather related injury or death.
